Tour Itinerary

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Day 1: Arrival in Khwai – Gateway to the Wild

Arrive in the heart of **Botswana's Khwai region**, a wildlife-rich corridor nestled between **Moremi Game Reserve** and **Chobe National Park**.

Check into your **cozy guesthouse**, surrounded by pristine wilderness and the natural sounds of the African bush. Day 2: Mokoro Experience – The Serenity of the Okavango Delta

After breakfast, immerse yourself in the **tranquil beauty of the Okavango Delta**. Glide silently through the **calm waterways in a traditional Mokoro**, expertly guided by a local poler.

Drift past **reeds and water lilies**, listen to the symphony of birdsong, and spot **kingfishers, herons, and African fish eagles**. Watch for elephants wading through the shallows, hippos snorting in the distance, and crocodiles basking along the banks.

This serene experience offers a rare chance to feel deeply connected to Botswana's wetland wilderness. Capture the moment from your low vantage point as the reflections of the Delta shimmer around you.

Return to camp refreshed and full of appreciation for this natural wonder.

Day 3: Journey to Mababe River – The Remote Frontier

After breakfast, depart northward toward **Mababe River Lodge**, a secluded haven set beside the vast **Mababe Depression**. The drive itself offers wildlife encounters and scenic landscapes, making it an extension of your safari adventure.

Arrive in time for a **late lunch** overlooking the floodplains and open savannah. After settling in, embark on an **afternoon game drive** through the remote concession, known for its untouched beauty and high wildlife density.

Spot **grazing antelope, zebra herds, and elephants**, as well as predators like **lions, leopards, and hyenas**. With minimal safari traffic, this is an intimate experience in pure wilderness. Conclude the day with **sundowners at sunset**, then return for a cozy **dinner at the lodge**.

Overnight: Mababe River Lodge

Day 4: Morning Game Drive & Bush Breakfast

Rise early for a **morning game drive** — the best time to witness the bush awakening. Spot **giraffes, zebras**, and possibly a **lion or leopard** returning from a night's hunt.

As the soft golden light spreads across the savannah, stop for a **bush breakfast** in a scenic clearing surrounded by birdsong and fresh morning air.

Return to the lodge mid-morning for relaxation and leisure. Spend your afternoon **unwinding by the pool** or simply soaking up the views from camp.

Overnight: Mababe River Lodge

Day 5: Mababe to Mwandi View – Along the Chobe River Floodplain

After breakfast, journey northeast to **Mwandi View**, a peaceful **riverside retreat** set along the scenic **Chobe River floodplain**. Enjoy sightings along the route — elephants, antelope, and the occasional predator may appear en route.



Check into your **comfortable riverside lodge** and enjoy **lunch with panoramic views** of the Chobe floodplain.

In the afternoon, head out on a **game drive** through nearby wildlife corridors. Spot **giraffes browsing acacias, zebras grazing, and elephants crossing the floodplain** on their way to water. Keep an eye out for **lions or hyenas** that often patrol the area.

Return to the lodge for **sundowners on the deck**, watching the golden glow fade across the landscape, followed by **dinner under the stars**.

Overnight: Mwandi View Lodge

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 6: Two Rivers Region – Chobe & Linyanti Wilderness

Today, travel west toward the **Two Rivers region**, where **Chobe National Park** meets **Linyanti Wildlife Reserve** — one of Botswana's richest wildlife zones.

Arrive at your lodge or camp in time for **lunch**, surrounded by the wild serenity of the bush. In the late afternoon, set out on a **game drive** through diverse landscapes — **riverine forests, open floodplains, and savanna woodlands**, home to elephants, lions, leopards, and abundant birdlife.

After the drive, transition into a **sunset boat cruise on the Chobe River**, a highlight of your journey. Glide past **hippos, crocodiles, and elephants**, with vibrant birdlife filling the air. As the sun sets over the water, raise a glass to Botswana's magic before returning to camp for dinner.

Overnight: Chobe / Two Rivers Area Lodge

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 7: Day Trip to Victoria Falls – “The Smoke That Thunders”

Start early and **cross the border into Zimbabwe** for a full-day excursion to **Victoria Falls**, one of the **Seven Natural Wonders of the World**. Locally known as *Mosi-oa-Tunya* (“The Smoke That Thunders”), the falls stretch over **1.7 kilometers** and plunge more than **100 meters** into the gorge below.

Explore **Victoria Falls National Park** on a guided or self-paced walk through lush rainforest trails nourished by the mist. Enjoy stunning viewpoints and the roar of cascading water.

Optional activities include:

1. **Helicopter Flight (“Flight of Angels”)** – a breathtaking aerial view of the falls.
2. **Local Craft Market Visit** – shop for handmade art and souvenirs.
3. **Riverside Lunch** overlooking the Zambezi River.

Return to Botswana by evening for your **final night in the wild**, celebrating with **sundowners and dinner** at your lodge.

Day 8: Departure

Enjoy your **final breakfast at the lodge**, soaking in the tranquil river views. Check out and transfer to the **Kasane or Maun Airport** for your onward flight.

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Booking Policy

1. To secure a reservation, the client is required to pay 30% of the total fee, of which some will be refundable depending on terms and conditions of third-party operators should the client decide not to travel. The company will endeavor to refund all due payments made in cases of cancellation.
2. Booking terms and conditions of ground operators apply on accommodation, meals, activities and transfers and we will inform the clients on important terms and conditions that affect them.
3. Validity of provisional bookings are from 2 weeks up to 3 months or more depending on availability status with third party operators.
4. Provisional bookings should be confirmed whenever possible 60 days or more prior to travel dates
5. No refunds for Department of Wildlife and National Parks bookings, park entry fees and vehicle fees. This particularly effect self drive safaris on 4x4 rentals
6. Once the deposit fee has been paid, amendments to the itinerary will be limited.

Cancellation policy

1. Booking cancellations are free and refundable except under the following circumstances once the client has paid the required deposit fee.
2. Should a cancellation be received between 30 and 60 days prior to due arrival date 20% of the contracted rate will be charged.
3. Should a cancellation be received between 30 and 10 days prior to due arrival date 50% of the contracted rate will be charged.
4. Should a cancellation be received 10 days or less days prior to due arrival date 100% of the contracted rate will be charged.
5. Cancellation and confirmation must be in writing by all parties concerned and sent via email
